
### PO at IA

# fundraising in brief



The PO has raised a total of \$57,235 thanks to the collective efforts of members and volunteers who assisted with a variety of fundraising activities. Bake sales and Alternative Dress accounted for almost 25% of all the monies raised.



Spookapalooza, IA's Family Night, Carols By Candlelight and the Gala event were the big events held over the past year. The PO's lead and support were fundamental to the successful execution of these fun and wonderful affairs. Your involvement, whether it was organizing, donating, or participating made a huge difference to these events which were enjoyed by the entire IA community.



Thanks to the PO, IA students enjoy a wealth of online resources. These include online libraries such as Questia used by Grade 11, 12 and 13, online teaching resources such as RAZ kids and Rockalingua for primary school students, MyMaths - a teaching and homework resource, and Vocabulary.com for grades 5 -9 among others.



The PO has provided many of the resources that students use on a day-to-day basis, such as: art supplies, music and drama supplies, library books, PE equipment and gardening equipment.



Thanks to funds raised by the PO, more than half of IA staff members completed basic First Aid training with Antigua and Barbuda Search and Rescue (ABSAR); we also got a new defibrillator machine.
