

## SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

At Island Academy, students are expected to wear PE uniform on scheduled PE days and semi-formal or formal uniform at all other times. **Students will be required to wear formal uniform on certain occasions, such as school photo day and special assemblies.**

If students wear unpermitted jewelry to school, it will be confiscated and kept in the safe until the end of the term. This includes, but is not limited to, earrings, bracelets and necklaces.

### Footwear

Both Primary and Secondary students are expected to have 2 pairs of shoes for school. **Dress shoes are black, leather or leather look, flat, and can be polished.** Running shoes or trainers are permitted for PE days, and should be as plain as possible.

### Primary Uniform

Navy blue skirt, shorts or skort (no more than two inches above the knee).  
White fitted blouse, or white polo shirt with IA logo on it.  
Black dress shoes with white/black ankle socks.  
Black leather belt (with shorts).

### Secondary Uniform

*DRESS/FORMAL:* Navy blue long trousers or skirt, white button-up shirt, blue school tie, black dress shoes, black/white socks and black belt.  
*SEMI-FORMAL/REGULAR:* Navy-blue trousers, skirt or shorts, white polo shirt with the IA school crest logo, black dress shoes, black/white socks and black belt.  
Trousers/shorts should be chinos or work style, not jeans. Skirts and shorts must be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee.

### PE Uniform (all ages)

Navy blue drawstring shorts, white t-shirt with IA logo, white socks and running shoes.

### Hair & Accessories

Students' hairstyles should be of a natural colour, and not interfere with learning.  
Hair accessories should be functional rather than aesthetic. Headbands/clips/scrunchies should not extend from the head or have attachments on them.  
If hair is long enough to tie up, it must be.  
Make-up and nail polish are not permitted.  
Jewelry is not permitted with the exception of one pair of small stud earrings and a watch (smartwatches are not permitted).



## Sanctions

Homeroom teachers will check uniform, including jewelry, once a week (varying days). It will also be checked as a whole school at line up each Tuesday.

Homeroom teachers should give students **three strikes** to correct uniform. Students require a note in their agenda from parents if they have the incorrect uniform (which cannot be immediately rectified, eg. no shoes on island).

After one warning, all jewelry will be confiscated, and given to the office with the students' name. The office will then put it in an envelope and put it in the safe until the end of term.

Sanctioning uniform should never get in the way of learning. Students should only be sent to the office in severe incidents, or if a student is being defiant.
