Students completing national, regional, and international examinations have made our school incredibly proud. IA continues to be a top performing high school with our Grade 11 graduating class producing impressive results in the Caribbean Secondary Examinations. Additionally, our post-16 International Baccalaureate graduates have gained admission, along with generous scholarships, to universities beyond the Caribbean and especially across North America; a reflection of the caliber of our students and the increasing opportunities our students have been able to access.

Our campus and extracurricular activities continue to thrive. We've introduced new after-school programs, including stilt-walking, ceramics, and an expanded sports curriculum.

The student council has been active, collaborating with FFIA (Friends and Family of Island Academy) to organize several community events throughout the year. Our student ambassadors, supported by Grade 9, participated in an international project with Global Social Leaders, a UK-based social advocacy charity. # 2023-2024 HIGHLIGHTS

## SCHOLARSHIPS FOR OUR IB GRADUATES

Nine graduates of the International Baccalaureate Diploma program collectively achieved 38 university acceptances throughout North America and the Caribbean. These remarkable students secured robust, merit-based scholarships from the institutions they enrolled in, an impressive accomplishment for such a small group. This year's valedictorian and recipient of donor funding, Chidindu Ohaegbulam, matriculated to Davidson College, a highly esteemed and selective liberal arts college in North Carolina, pursuing an engineering track to a Masters program at Columbia University. He received Davidson's flagship scholarship, the John M. Belk Scholarship, and has the added prestige of being selected as an Alvarez scholar which recognizes outstanding international students.

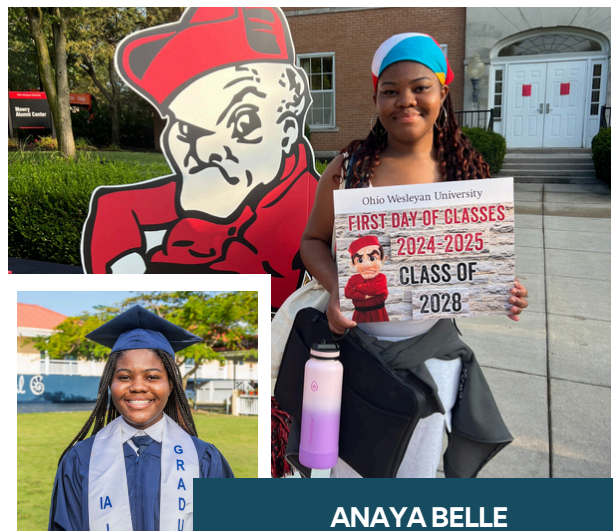

Other students included Jahlisa Daniel, who is currently studying Biology at the University of Arizona, and Jabin Siltson, who has enrolled at Georgia State University to major in Economics while also having the chance to join the esteemed Georgia State University Band program. Closer to home, we have Tatyana Philip, who gained acceptance into a medicine program at St. George's University in Grenada, as well as Naraiya Michaels and Archilles Meyers who are both attending the local campus of the University of the West Indies, with Naraiya studying Business and Archilles focusing on Computer Science.

## IA ESTABLISHES PARTNERSHIP WITH US UNIVERSITY

In March 2024, we partnered with Ohio Wesleyan University (OWU) to offer a qualifying IA student guaranteed needs-based aid for four years. This collaboration was made possible thanks to the unwavering commitment of one of our donors, Mr. Roger Lockwood, an alumnus of OWU and the dedicated efforts of our counseling team at IA. Anaya Belle, an IA bursary recipient, became the inaugural beneficiary of this partnership, successfully securing thousands in grants and scholarships each year.

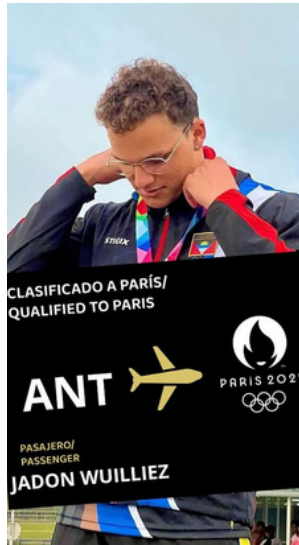
## INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT ACROSS CAMPUS

Throughout the year, we accomplished several infrastructure enhancements on campus, including the replacement of the roof on the entire administrative block. We also renovated student restrooms and installed outdoor lighting and an outdoor PA system.

Additionally, we initiated work on a new building that will pay tribute to the late Sir Roland and Lady Nina Franklin. This multifaceted space will house an auditorium-type hall with a built-in stage, an administrative office, kitchen and 3 classrooms and bathroom amenities. It will be used for academic and sports classes and events such as school performances and graduations. This new building is projected to be finished by December 2025.

3. Excavation works for new building

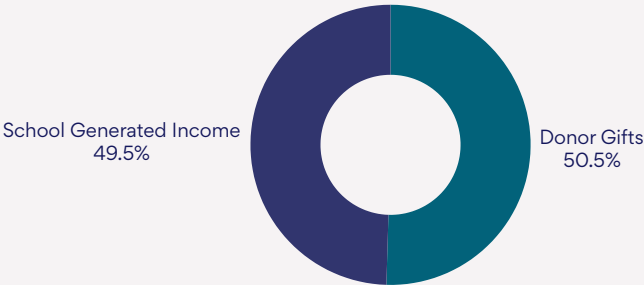


## IA ALUMNI COMPETE AT PARIS 2024 OLYMPICS

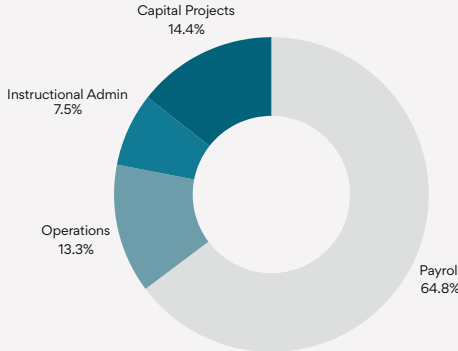
